1. Top Free and Affordable Movie Streaming Websites

The winter series will begin on a cozy note, exploring the world of online entertainment. Members will be introduced to reliable, free, and low-cost streaming platforms, learning how to find high-quality movies without overspending—and without encountering unsafe sites.

2. Using Voice Commands to Take Photos

4. Using PowerPoint: Generate QR Codes and Images, and Address Security Issues Related to QR Codes

Members will discover surprising features inside PowerPoint—creating custom QR codes, generating images, and understanding how malicious QR codes can pose risks. This hands-on session will prepare everyone to use QR technology safely and creatively.

5. Computer Gurus You Can Trust

Finding trustworthy tech help can be difficult, so this presentation will provide guidance on how to recognize reputable computer technicians and online resources. Members will learn how to avoid scams, spot red flags, and identify experts who genuinely know their craft.

6. PDF Editing and Management

Since PDFs appear everywhere, this session will demystify PDF editing: adding text, combining pages, signing documents, and exporting to different formats. Whether for personal use or volunteer work, members will gain confidence in managing this universal file type.

7. Understanding Cloud Storage and Its Uses

The Club will turn upward—into the cloud. Attendees will learn what cloud storage really is, the difference between syncing and backing up, and how platforms such as OneDrive, Google Drive, and Dropbox can fit into everyday digital life.

8. Bluetooth: What It Is, and Common Uses

Bluetooth will take the spotlight in a fun, approachable session explaining how this familiar but often misunderstood technology works. Members will explore practical uses, from connecting earbuds and speakers to transferring files and using wireless keyboards.

9. Smartwatches Designed for Everyday Use and Health Monitoring

Wearable tech will be featured as members compare leading smartwatches. The presentation will highlight features for daily convenience—notifications, timers, navigation—and health tools such as heart-rate monitoring, fall detection, sleep tracking, and ECG capability.

10. Backup Theories, Rules, and Providers; Using OneDrive from Various Locations

Winter is the perfect time for digital housekeeping, so the Club will dedicate a session to backups. Members will learn backup rules (like the 3-2-1 method), common mistakes, and how to access and manage OneDrive backups whether they're at home, traveling, or using shared computers.

11. Understanding Camera Settings and Their Proper Use

Photography enthusiasts will enjoy an in-depth look at camera basics—ISO, shutter speed, aperture, focus modes, and white balance. Whether using a phone or a dedicated camera, everyone will gain insight into taking clearer, better photos.

12. Managing the Pictures You Have

The winter series will conclude with a practical session on organizing digital photos. Members will learn how to sort, label, delete duplicates, create albums, and store images safely—turning cluttered libraries into collections they can easily find and enjoy.
